

## BRYANSTON RIVER CLUB COMMUNITY FORUM No.133

### APPLICATION FOR RESTRICTION OF ACCESS TO PUBLIC PLACES FOR SAFETY AND SECURITY PURPOSES REFERENCE: 133

The access restriction structures were originally erected in 1997. In 2020 the residents are renewing the existing closures listed below.

The access restriction structure as applied for in 2003/ 2014/ 2016 and now in 2020 involves:

1. 5 automated manned boom gates, with 24/7 pedestrian access on:
  - Sycamore Road at its intersection with Ballyclare Drive
  - East Hertford Road at its intersection with Coleraine Drive
  - Borrowdale Road at its intersection with Coleraine Drive (gate to be closed between 19:00 and 06:00)
  - Brooke Road at its intersection with Bryanston Drive (gate to be closed between 19:00 and 06:00);
  
2. 4 Locked Palisade gates:
  - a. Jacaranda Avenue intersection with Coleraine Drive
  - b. Oak Avenue intersection with Coleraine Drive
  - c. Elm Road intersection with Coleraine Drive
  - d. East River Road at its intersection with Bryanston Drive

In 2020 the residents are applying for permission to implement automated manned booms providing the residents with:

- Ensuring 24/7 access to the area for all persons/vehicles
- Reduced crime levels
- Installation of cameras at the booms that are manned 24/7 by guard in control room (**should funding be sufficient**)
- 24/7 Remote operation of manned booms (**should funding be sufficient**)

Currently the application enjoys support from:

- 80.8% support of the residents in the area (based on 2016 renewal application forms)
- The local Ward Councillor
- The CPF

The Traffic Impact Study concluded in 2020 also supports this application.

The application has been made in the name of Bryanston/Riverclub North Security Association, an association formed for that purpose. In 2015 the Bryanston Riverclub North Security Association changed its name to the Bryanston River Club Community Forum NPC (2015/110329/08 ) established to manage the collective interests common to all its members
